2023 Mission Report

Monies received from First Baptist Church in 2023 was used to assist this agency in the purchase of food supplies for our essential food pantry program. In 2023, CMLC purchased over \$65,000.00 in food out of our working budget as well as utilized over \$180,000.00 in donated food items for Logan County residents in need.

This agency also uses your funding as a match in funds for our "Emergency Solution Grant" (ESG) Homelessness Program. 60% of this crucial program's funds come from the Department of Local Affairs and the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless. However, this agency must show that it will receive at least 50% in matching funds throughout the grant cycle to assist in funding the ESG Homelessness Program. Without local church support, this agency would have a difficult time implementing this program for those that are experiencing homelessness within Logan County.

2023 Mission Report

Our family kicked off 2023 by spending two weeks serving in Guatemala. While there we helped build a home for a family in need, built three stoves for families, did outreach programs across the Country, and served in the local orphanage we partner with through Child Beyond International.

We spent the rest of the year doing evangelistic events all throughout the United States. We partnered with 94 different churches and Christian organizations in 29 different states. Many of these events were one-night programs where churches bring people together to see an illusion show and hear the gospel shared. In addition to outreach, we also were able to speak at many churches' Christian camps. In these events, the focus is often on building strong families.

The final major aspect of our ministry this year has been partnering with non-profit organizations to help them raise funds and further their mission. A recent example is "Man in the Mirror" - a Christian organization focused on building strong Christian men.

It certainly is a blessing to have the opportunity to champion the cause of churches and organizations who are using their gifts, abilities, and resources to grow the kingdom. Our desire is to do the same.

We are beyond grateful for your prayers and support as our family continues to follow God wherever He leads us in 2024!

Uganda Ministry update 2023

Leviticus 19:34 ESV: *“You shall treat the stranger who sojourns with you as the native among you, and you shall love him as yourself, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the Lord your God.”*

When I started serving God in Uganda in 2010, I had no idea how He planned to use me. My understanding was limited, but God has grown my faith exponentially. I began doing mission work out of obedience to a calling. I was seeking peace and had learned obedience brings peace.

During a three-month summer stay, I helped host a youth conference with about 200 students aged 18 to 30. One of the students who helped emcee was Reuben Muhindo. I began discipling him and some of his classmates by teaching at their weekly college fellowship. They were all studying to become Clinical Officers. I taught a lesson on *Viral Discipleship*, and God used it to launch Reuben into medical ministry.

Fast forward to 2019. Reuben and his wife, Lillian, are married and operate a small clinic. Lillian is a midwife. As we headed into 2020, they moved their clinic to the village of Kakindo.

Besides the worldwide pandemic and the shelter-in-place status, I was recovering from open heart surgery, sepsis, and COVID. I had been in the hospital for 40 days, and 21 of them were in quarantine. I didn't want to waste the year, so Reuben and I started planning to build a clinic. The Huenink Care Clinic was born. They serve 10 villages and receive 40-125 patients per month. When we host free medical camps, over 500 people attend in a day or two.

What sets the clinic apart is the Christian love and respect they treat their patients with - A quality not often experienced at other medical facilities. Patients know that they can get both prescriptions and prayer. Even those who practice Islam feel welcome and cared for. They are surprised they can receive care in a Christian medical clinic, a testament to our inclusive and compassionate approach. This unique aspect of our ministry has allowed us to reach a wider audience and make a greater impact.

In its 2nd year of being fully operational, the clinic is still striving to be self-sustaining. We supplement the staff wages monthly with \$500 and save extra funds for medical equipment. The immediate desire is a \$2500 piece of land that borders the clinic. This land, currently being farmed, would benefit the staff & families with food. Then, as additional funds can be obtained, we'd like to add a theater for general surgeries. Your generosity has contributed to many of these specific needs, helping us to expand our services and reach.

The Care Clinic is just one ministry in Uganda. Over the years, four primary schools have been built, two other smaller clinics, two church plants, etc. We also teach pastors in a program called the International Training Institute and have developed a Community Health Evangelism Program. A ministry to Muslims has developed, which I never saw coming, and it has been rewarding - Building Relationship Strong Enough to Hold the Gospel. I have so many “Modern-day Book of Acts” stories to share. The financial constraints can be burdensome, but I trust God to bless whatever he wants to see flourish.

I am happy to speak to the congregation any time.

PRAYER POINTS FOR THIS 2024


1. For more souls coming to the Lord and be baptized than in 2024

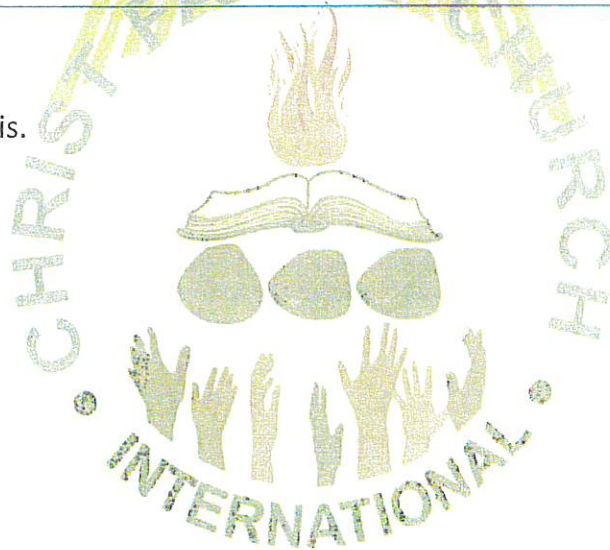
